Creative Hands Biennial to Open

Creative Hands: Selected Works by Pacific Artists is a biennial juried exhibition at the Isla Center for the Arts. Dr. Nancy Mithlo, juror for the exhibition, is a Professor in the Department of Gender Studies at the University of California Los Angeles. She holds PhD and MA degrees in Anthropology from Stanford University and a BA in Anthropology and Art from Appalachian State University. She has extensive curatorial experience having curated/co-curated over 21 exhibitions, including nine displays for the Venice Biennale between 2001 and 2017.

The Isla Center for the Arts received 118 submissions from 23 artists for consideration. Dr. Nancy Mithlo, selected 26 works created by 15 artists for the exhibition.
